Principal's Report- Ms. Dyson

- Comprehensive Support Improvement Meeting Update- CSI site visit went well. Ms.
 Dyson stated that different school leaders helped to present to the state visitors. The
 feedback from the state was great. The state is excited to hear about the wonderful
 things being done at Metro. Some highlighted areas are listed below.
 - Intervention Learning Lab (A4.01)
 - OSTT (Re-teach, re-group, re-assessment)
 - Summer and beyond- The OSTT program is Metro's version of tutoring and extended support. Ms. Strong runs our OSTT program. We are seeing positive results and want to continue to support our students. Ms. Dyson has a meeting with the NOW! Program soon to discuss how we can continue.
 - Student Intervention and Support
 - Curriculum Resources for targeted intervention- In addition to the OSTT program, that space that is being used for the tutoring program will be turned into an intervention lab.
 Materials and furniture have been selected with the help of our service providers such as OT and PT. Teachers also attended the Exceptional Children's Convention recently and were able to bring back strategies.
 - Media Center- PTO has partnered with the school to help remodel our media center with new furniture that is conducive to learning and creating that flexible seating.
 - Out-Teach Learning Lab (Report given by AP's)-See below
- <u>Prioritized Staffing</u> CSI funds and the district have labeled Metro as a school out of 32 others that will receive prioritized staffing. As of now, based on the intent form that

was sent out by the district, Metro's needs are below. It is noted that we have reduced the need for teachers since last year. We have decreased the need by 3 teacher positions. The upcoming hiring events for CMS are listed below. Metro has a team that will go to recruit.
