ACT WorkKeys Assessments

Starting on November 30, students that qualify will begin taking the ACT WorkKeys assessments. These assessments evaluate job-based skills that your student has accumulated over the span of their CTE courses. This also allows them an opportunity to earn a National Career Readiness Certificate, which is recognized by many employers around the nation. Students that qualify for the WorkKeys assessments have received an email regarding their test date in their student email account. All testing will be in the Media Center starting at 7:15 AM. If your student received a testing email from Mr. Riley please be sure that they also bring their Chromebooks fully charged, as this test is an online format. Students are welcome to bring a calculator and #2 pencils. The ACT Workkeys test is comprised of three sections. Important News from the Cafeteria

Students Without Meal Money

All students must have an approved meal application, cash or money on account to make lunch purchases. Procedures are in place for Pre-k, elementary and middle school students who do not have money to receive a complete lunch. The price of the lunch will be charged to the student's account. The student will be asked to return any extra items on his/her tray to the cashier. Parents will be notified of balances due and are responsible for payment. If payment is not received within 10 days of the date of the notice, the matter will be referred to the school principal for further action. High school students are not allowed to go into the negative to purchase any food items. There is a "no charge" policy in high schools. High school lunch is \$3.00.

At the beginning of the school year or during the school year, if a student moves from a CEP school to a school that is not CEP the parent must complete a meal application within 30 days to be considered for meal benefits. Students will need to have money for meals if an approved meal application is not on file.

Adding Money On Accounts

Parents are encouraged to place money in their student's accounts in advance. Advance payment allows the cafeteria to provide the most efficient service to all customers.

Money may be placed in your student's account for the convenience of purchasing extra items for students.

Signing up for PAYPAMS

Step 1: Register with PAMS: Visit paypams.com or you can also call 1-877-726-7586.

Step 2: Choose your Payment Options: Make manual payments at your convenience or set up automatic payments.

Step 3: Make a Payment: Pay by credit or VISA logo debit card. You will receive an immediate confirmation that your payment has been received. (Payments take 24 to 48 hours to post to your student's account at their school cafeteria.)
