I. School Uniform Policy

- Reviewed the original email request from parent. Explained the pros.
- Dr. Harris explained approval process.
 - 70% of parents to agree to vote
 - 75% need to vote yes
- Would the benefits outweigh the effort of implementing a uniform policy.
- SLT Secret Ballot on whether or not to move forward.
 - 13 No
 - 3 Yes
- SLT voted to not move forward with school uniforms.
- SLT will address the uniform issue every 3 years, if it is suggested by a parent.

II. School Improvement Plan

- Goals: CCR
 - ELA 15% point increase (74.2% to 89.2%)
 - Math 10 % point increase (83.1% to 93.1%)
 - K-2 15% point increase (71% to 86%)
- Additional Goal - Instructional Alignment and language will be consistent from one grade to another.
- Teacher training over the summer.
- Walk-throughs are being conducted to ensure implementation.
- Differentiated learning Lab (40 minute Learning Lab 4 days/week) to address students at all levels: above, at and below grade level.
