I. Principal's Update

- a. 20th Day Headcount results; enrollment numbers were lower than district had anticipated, therefore a teacher had to be displaced.
- b. Ms. Mueller, 4th grade teacher, was moved to Elizabeth Lane (last teacher hired).

- c. Number of students allowed in classroom determined the changes to 4th grade team; current team has reworked their schedule to accommodate.
 - d. Discussion about school boundary changes and possible students Selwyn could potentially lose, as a result. Mr. Lis explained that 5th grade students are grandfathered, based on it being a graduation year. Siblings may be able to stay at school, if hardship is determined. Mr. Lis also discussed potential population growth with new local housing.
- II. Title IX
- a. All lessons successfully taught the Week of 9/25.
 - b. Mr. Richardson shared that conversations escalated with some of his students about examples in media that involved bullying and violence. This type of conversation was stopped but Richardson. He wanted to let parents know that these students are aware of many things happening in society, through social media.
- III. SIP
- a. Dr. Harris made revisions to satisfy feedback from area superintendent and executive director; bulleted items were added to “Evidence of Success” for individual goals.
 - b. Final review done by SLT. Few items related to accuracy in numbers were reviewed. Team gave approval & signed off.

- a. Parent teacher conferences coming up.
 - b. Friday Night Lights was very successful.
