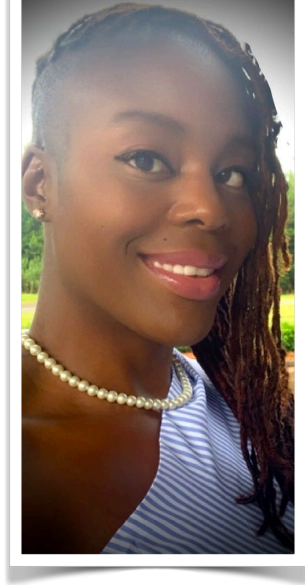


LETTER FROM ZAKI BAKER, PTA PRESIDENT
