1. Review of End of Year MAP data. Overall student cohorts have either maintained or grown in both reading and math. The comparison was largely positive and can be attributed to effective classroom instruction. The state legislature is looking at changing the school report card criteria to 50% proficiency/50% growth. They are also considering changing the 15-point scale to a 10-point scale.

2. Upcoming revised K-2 report card. Revisions are minor, but should help parents to better understand the standards (less educational jargon). The standards have been re-written in "I Can" statements. Teachers will not fully assess a child on a particular standard until the standard has been fully taught. There has been a clarification of the rating scale to reflect mastery learning by shifting from a numerical scale to a more descriptive letter based scale. This shift allows students to show growth in their learning over time.

3. SLT worked to designate 12 remaining workdays as optional or required. SLT members voted and days were decided.

5. Open Discussion

- Title IX-One lesson regarding harassment and bullying behaviors from the district must be taught prior to the end of this school year. Grade level specific and developmentally appropriate lessons will be taught by classroom teachers to give students tools to report concerns to a trusted adult and express their feelings to others. Teachers were walked through modules and all components of the lesson through an online CANVAS module. We anticipate that at least one such lesson will be delivered annually. Lessons will be updated and refined over time.
- Curriculum Night will be rebranded for next year. We are hopeful to increase parent engagement and participation that evening.
- OLC-Stem Committee has designated one bed per grade level. Plantings will be done before the end of the school year. The science resource room will be connected to the OLC.
