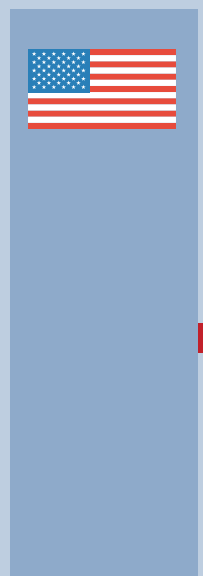
NASP aspires to protect children from gun violence by encouraging and supporting solutions that create safer schools, homes and communities to stop the tragic loss of life.

Two thirds by suicide

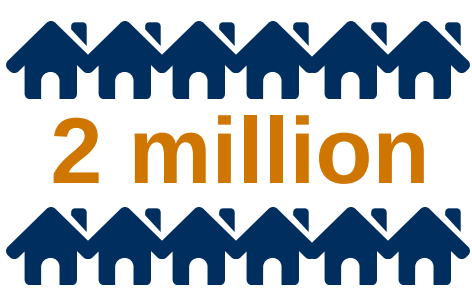


The rate of firearm related deaths in the U.S. is

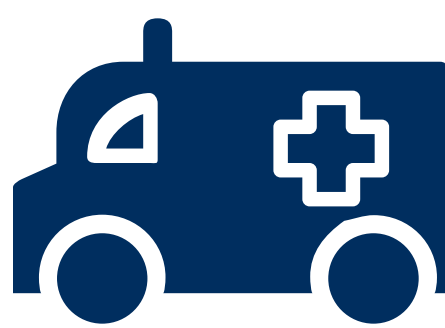


2 million
