I. Call to Order

IV. Athletic Updates / New Business - Brian Mobley

Middle School Athletics: Targeting January for kids to play again. Not sure in what capacity, most likely Spring sports only. Middle school sports are not the priority right now, more focus on high school. Davidson Youth Baseball Association has come forward to offer Davidson K-8 the opportunity to have a team. There would possibly be 2-4 teams playing in this single conference. Brandyn offered to run football starting in 5th grade as a club sport with the Lake Norman Giants.

V. Treasury – Joe Bruderek

We are setup with accounts and fully functional. We received a \$3k loan from the PTO and are waiting on an additional \$3k from donations and sponsorships which have been verbally committed. We have \$1700 that will be due for the initial Spirit Wear order. Joe to setup PayPal and Venmo in order to facilitate the purchase of spirit wear.

The shed/storage container is still at the top of the list for an item that we would like to purchase. Ideally, purchase and installed by November 1.



Brian has confirmed we should move forward with approaching sponsors via the targeted company list which will be shared by Cam and Jeremy. Joe suggested putting together participating in "Giving Day" in November to make donating to the Booster Club an option.

VI. Brick Program – Elliott Love

The company we will move forward with is Polar Engraving. They will provide the bricks and engraving. Cost to us is \$18 per 4x8 brick. Contractor will do the installation. We need to determine the area of the install to quantify how many bricks we need. Two areas to consider would be car rider line and the area out front around the Japanese maple.

The turnaround time is very quick.

VII. Spirit Wear – Brandyn Michalak

Showed a couple of t-shirts and hats and discussed some color changes. \$20 for the 50/50 blend t-shirts and \$25 for the hats.

We should begin promoting the spirit wear on Facebook and the Tiger Tribune.

Pick a Friday to sell t-shirts on the green. We need a banner or tablecloth with our logo to provide visibility. First day to sell is October 2 in-person on the green.
