Dear Parents/Guardians,

East Mecklenburg High School will offer several options this summer for students in need of repeat course work, new coursework or virtual credit recovery. Please review our options below to learn more about each program.

Camp CMS

Camp CMS is a free six-week IN-PERSON summer learning and enrichment program for rising 9th - 12th grade students. The program is designed to address unfinished instruction due to the impact that COVID-19 had on master learning this school year. Students currently attending East Mecklenburg High School will have the option to select from one of the following programs through Camp CMS:

Summer Preparation Academy (SPA) – This program is offered to rising 9th – 12th grade students who are interested in coursework to suppress a failing grade in an EOC course or to take one of the following courses - ACT Prep, Sociology, Psychology or Foundations of Math II. Students may take up to 2 new courses and earn 1 credit per course. Students will attend school for 3 hours per day per course for six weeks.

Credit Recovery - This program is offered to rising 10th – 12th grade students who are interested in retaking a **failed EOC course** to recover the course credit. Students will have the opportunity to take up to 4 credits and earn a Pass/Fail by demonstrating mastery. Students who elect to recover a required EOC course IN-PERSON must attend for a minimum of three weeks per course.

Current East Mecklenburg students who select a program through Camp CMS will attend IN-PERSON summer learning at Myers Park High School. Camp CMS will run from June 14th – July 29th. There will be no school on July 5th – July 9th. The tentative hours will be from 7:15 a.m. – 2:15 p.m. Students taking one course may attend a partial day.

East Mecklenburg students who would like to enroll in Camp CMS for IN-PERSON learning at Myers Park High School, should complete the registration form at <http://bit.ly/EastMeckCampCMS>.

Edgenuity Credit Recovery Program

Students who have failed a course and do not enroll in Camp CMS will automatically be enrolled in credit recovery through Edgenuity. Edgenuity is an online learning platform that provides an opportunity for students who have failed a core content course to recover credit in a remote setting. Students can complete 2 credit recovery courses in Phase 1 and two credit recovery courses in Phase 2. The time to complete all course work for credit is limited, and students may not carry work from one phase to the next. Phase I will run from June 7th – June 30th and Phase 2 will run from July 6th – July 29th. Each student will be assigned a teacher mentor that can assist with instruction and troubleshoot technical issues. Students are expected to work from 9:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday. **Parents and guardians may elect to opt out of this opportunity however the loss of credit(s) may result in grade level retention and/or may impact graduation status.**

To access an Edgenuity course students will:

- 1) Type in Edgenuity.com
- 2) Click the login button - student login
- 3) Student usernames are cms + student ID + * (*cms12345678**)
- 4) Student passwords are birthday month and year *mmyyyy* (*062005 for June 2005*)


