Q: What is your favorite candy?

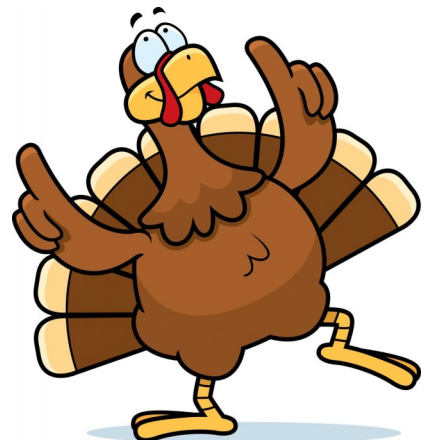

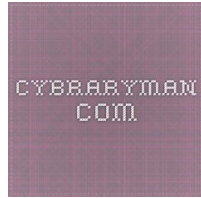

Apple Toffee Dip
