Learning does not stop over break!

Why read over break? **Reading keeps the brain moving. Comprehension can help kids retain important information and get them geared up for the second half of the school year.**

To aid in this endeavor, First Ward is presenting “Book Challenge Bingo” to give your child an incentive to read each day over winter break. We will have individual prizes for the student that reads the most pages, class prizes for the classroom that reads the most pages and various other prizes like homework passes.

The rules are simple:

1. Choose a column to get started. The goal is to read a book for each square in the column.
2. Read a book that matches one of the categories listed on the squares. When you’ve finished reading the book, cross off the square AND write the title on the back of the BINGO card.
3. Once you get BINGO (a line completed either down, across, or diagonal). An adult and the student please sign the back of the card. You can keep going to see if you can get the whole card completed.

*K-2 parents feel free to read to your child as needed.

If your student uses the excuse “I do not have anything to read”:


Each CMS student has a Charlotte Mecklenburg library ONE ACCESS card that you can use online for ebooks with an electronic device or at any of Charlotte Mecklenburg’s Library locations in person. All you need to know is your student id number and the PIN is the year you were born. Online – go to Charlotte Mecklenburg Library and click on account at the top.

If your student does not know their student ID number, it will be on power school or is on the recently sent home assignment letter from CMS.
