



Technology Expectations

Dear Parents,

We are very excited to provide our families the opportunity to have an iPad (K-2) or a Chrome book (3-5) this year. With this opportunity also comes responsibility for our children. This document is a contract, which we will adhere to as we establish remote learning protocols within our school.

Security and Damages Responsibility to keep the device secure rests with the individual owner.

The devices borrowed from the school should be for educational purposes. Any student discovered to be using the device for any other activity will have the device taken away and they will have to use other means to access the curriculum. We ask that our parents talk to students about care for their Grand Oak devices and provide expectations and consequences for lost, misplaced, or broken technology devices. The student needs to understand that it is their responsibility to be accountable for their own devices. If students damage devices, families can be held responsible for potential repairs due to mis-use.

Technology-Student Agreement

The use of technology to provide educational material is not a necessity, but a privilege. A student does not have the right to use his or her device without their parent permission at home. When technology is respected, it will benefit the learning environment as a whole. Students must adhere to the Student Code of Conduct, as well as all CMS Board policies, particularly Internet Acceptable Use Policy and Internet Safety.

Furthermore, the student must agree to the following conditions:

- The student takes full responsibility for his or her technology device.
- The technology may not be used to cheat on assignments or tests, or for non-instructional purposes such as texting or messaging unless school related and appropriate.
- The student should only access files on the computer or internet sites which are relevant to the classroom curriculum.
- The students cannot download apps to their devices without school permission.
- Grand Oak has the right to collect and examine any device if we believe someone is not using them appropriately.
- Cyber bullying refers to “bullying that is done electronically through the internet” and that causes physical or emotional harm to the victim, or disrupts school activities. This will not be tolerated and will result in the loss of use of the device.
- Never allow food or drink to be used around devices.

I understand and will abide by the above policy and guidelines. I further understand that any violation is unethical and may result in the loss of privileges as well as other disciplinary action **(this document can be kept at home)**.
