- Whose point of view is telling the story? Does the point of view change?

Non-Fiction Responses

- What do you already know about this topic? Write down 2-3 facts.
- What text features do you notice in the book? List 2-3 and tell how they help explain the information.
- What questions do you still have about your topic? What new questions came up during your reading? Write 1-2 questions you still have.
- What are some new facts you have learned in this text? List 2-3 new facts and their page numbers.
- Create a new title for the book. Why did you choose it?
