Proctors are needed for End of Grade Testing

EOGS are standardized tests required by the State of North Carolina. All third through fifth grade students take tests in Math and Reading. Fifth grade students will also take an EOG in Science.

What is proctoring?	A proctor is an adult (Registered CMS Volunteer) assigned to a testing session that is responsible for assisting the test administrator (teacher) during testing.
What does a proctor do?	A proctor attends a one-time training (TBA) on test security and the NC Testing Code of Ethics. During testing, a proctor will assist the test administrator (the teacher) with monitoring students to ensure a fair testing environment.
How many proctors are needed?	Each test session requires a proctor. We will need the help of 35 proctors (per day)!
When are proctors needed?	7:30-2:00 Friday, May 24th 7:30-2:00 Tuesday, May 28th 7:30-1:00 Wednesday, May 29th 7:30-1:00 Thursday, May 30th
