



Dress Code

- Shorts, dresses, and skirts should be worn no shorter than **four inches** from the top of the knee
- Scholars must wear **shoes** at all times. Scholars will not be allowed to wear bedroom shoes.
- Offensive/suggestive writing, (per CMS Code of Conduct/JMA Administration) on clothing or jewelry is prohibited, which includes advertising of alcohol, controlled substances, tobacco products or promotion of violence.
- Headgear: such as, scarves, bandanas, stocking caps, hoods, hats, towels, doo-rags, visors, and combs are not to be worn in the school building, unless approved by administration
- Clothing should be worn with appropriate undergarments and undergarments should not be visible.
- Inappropriate dress is prohibited, which includes tube and tank tops with straps less than **three fingertips** in length, revealing low neckline shirts, strapless, too short, too tight, see-through clothing and muscle shirts.
- Pants WILL NOT be worn with tears, holes or frayed above the knee that exposes the skin
- All tights, leggings (jeggings), and yoga pants must be worn with a shirt or skirt that is finger-tip length or longer.
