 - a. ACT Results
 - i. Overall good news
 - ii. 61.7% scored the composite score of 17 or higher
 - iii. In a two year span, we have increased this number by two percentage points
 - iv. Preliminary Results
 - v. Average composite score went up two/three tenths of a point
 - vi. Individual subject tests are displayed
 - vii. 95% of students did participate, we do believe that we achieved student participation in each individual subgroup
 - viii. Teacher mentoring process did help students improve their grades
