- **Updates**

- Growth data received and emailed to teachers

- **Discipline**
 - Hallway & Pass Etiquette (suggestions)
 - Frequent skippers can be added to a “No Exit” list where they are prohibited from leaving class without an escort

 - Teachers should include instructions for passes in sub plans
 - Students leaving at lunch and returning with fast food = need supervision in the student parking lot
 - Students should not be leaving the cafeteria and then going to the media center, even if they have a pass for the media center
