- **Updates**

- Official EOC results are posted
 - 10% increase in students' grade level proficiency
 - 11% increase in college/career readiness
- Personnel = MCHS is fully staffed
- Professional development room open in the media center--encourage PLCs to utilize more for planning
- New purchase requests due by the end of March (\$1500 per dept.)
- Registration begins 2-15-18
 - Students will register in PowerSchool during 2nd block
 - Counselors will meet 1-1 with students beginning 2-19
 - Majority of students will meet with counselors via their English classes
- Report cards distributed Friday, 2-16

- Athletics
 - Indoor track's medley relay team qualified for state championship
 - 7 wrestlers qualified for state championship
 - Ladies basketball in conference play-offs
 - Spring sports begin today, 2-14-18
 - Step team wins a competition

- Arts
 - Many students recognized with Keys and Honorable Mentions at the Scholastic Arts and Writing Competition
 - A professional ceramic artist will work with Art dept. and students to create an artistic tile project in the media center
 - International Festival, presented by the Multicultural Society will be held Saturday, 5-19-18
- Other Disciplines
 - Math competition held at UNC Charlotte will host 8 MCHS students on 3-5-18
 - EC dept. Hoping to receive more teacher feedback regarding accommodations that students do not consistently utilize (e.g. separate setting) so that these can be removed from individual IEPs
 - CTE will send 6 teams to the Teens TSA competition in Boone on Tues., 2-20-18
- **Attendance**
 - Truancy is a significant problem for MCHS students, particularly with seniors
 - R. Smith proposes forming an attendance committee who, along with a social worker and police officer, will conduct home visits
 - Committee would meet monthly
 - An appeals committee also needs to be put into place for students hoping to appeal their absences
 - SLT will begin planning to implement said committees for the 2018-2019 school year
- **Grading**
 - CMS reassessment policy is open to interpretation
 - MCHS has its own reassessment policy
 - No retesting for AP classes
 - Individual PLCs create and implement their own retesting policies
 - Should we make adjustments to these policies?
 - Revisit this issue during the March meeting
 - Modifications would be vetted through Instructional Excellence Team
