- **Grading Plan**
 - The committee reviewed copies of both the CMS retesting policy and the Mallard Creek retesting policy. We found that language is similar in both policies; thus, Mallard Creek is closely aligned with district standards.
 - Mallard Creek's policies differs from the CMS policy in that it notes that retesting is not offered in AP courses; PLCS develop their own retesting guidelines for Honors and Standard classes.
 - The committee chooses to maintain the current Mallard Creek retesting policy; however, PLCs should include a rationale for their guidelines in their syllabi (e.g. why Honors courses may only be permitted one retest per quarter).

- **Learning Contracts**

- Learning contracts can be developed by PLCs to provide at risk students a pathway to passing the course.
 - PLCs must collaborate to develop the objectives of the learning contract; these should reflect the minimum requirements for the course (e.g. English III = research paper and NC Final Exam)
 - All teachers within a PLC must offer at risk students the agreed upon learning contract; these may be limited to student enrolled in standard level classes
 - Students on a learning contract cannot score above a 60% for the class
