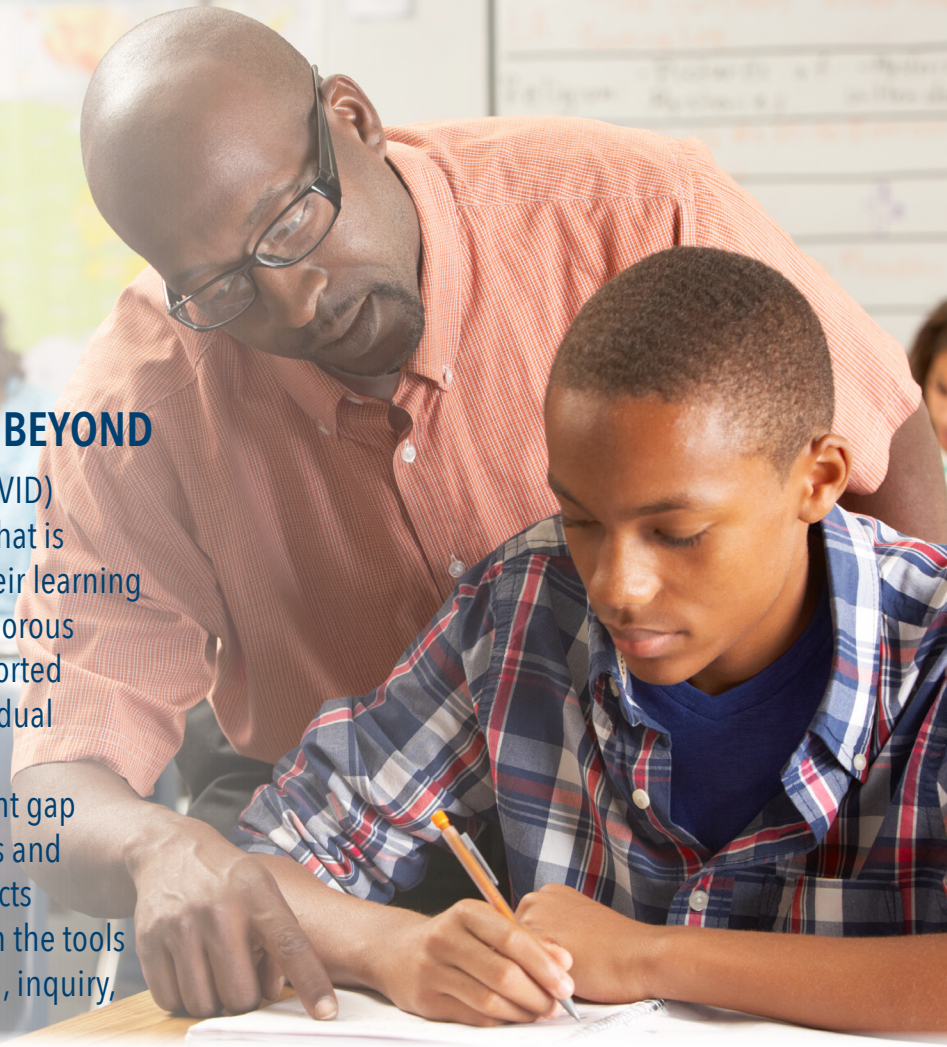




AVID



PREPARATION FOR COLLEGE AND BEYOND

Advancement via Individual Determination (AVID) is a college readiness system for all students that is designed to increase student ownership of their learning and provide teachers with skills to increase rigorous instruction for all students. Students are supported in taking advanced coursework, including AP, dual enrollment, and honors courses.

The mission of AVID is to close the achievement gap by preparing all students for college readiness and success in a global society. In CMS, AVID impacts students schoolwide by providing all staff with the tools to intentionally teach students skills in writing, inquiry, collaboration, organization, and reading.

WHY IS AVID IMPORTANT?

- AVID increases students' college readiness
- AVID skills help enable students to succeed in high school, higher education, and beyond.
- AVID schools have increased attendance
- AVID students have a higher college enrollment rate
- AVID students outperform their non-AVID peers on state assessments and national standardized tests
- AVID increases in the numbers of teachers who saw a positive change in the behavior of students and how students learned

MALLARD CREEK HS GOALS

- By the spring of 2023, 60% of the class of 2024 will be enrolled in or having taken at least one course of rigor (honors) e.g., AP®, or dual enrollment)
- By the spring of 2024, 85% of the class of 2024 will complete college entrance requirements
- By the spring of 2024, 85% of the class of 2024 will have applied to college
- By the spring of 2024, 80% of the class of 2024 will be accepted to college
