College Foundation of North Carolina College Application Week will begin **Monday, October 18, 2021** and conclude on **Friday, October 22, 2021**. Myers Park High School counselors and volunteers will be available to assist students **Tuesday, October 19 thru Thursday, October 21** in ParkIt during all 5 lunches. During this time, seniors will have an opportunity to receive help with completing their applications online and have fees waived by participating North Carolina colleges.

### UPCOMING TESTING:

- Pre-ACT: All 10th graders will take the Pre-ACT on **Monday, October 11, 2021**. (Full Instructional Day w/Students Attending Block 4 at the Conclusion)
- PSAT: All 10th and 11th graders will take the PSAT on **Wednesday, October 13, 2021**. (Early Release Day)

For the Pre-ACT and PSAT, all students will report to SEL/Advisory class. During the Pre-ACT, teachers with students in grade 9, 11, and 12 will assign work to be completed via Canvas while 10<sup>th</sup> graders are taking the test. During the PSAT, teachers with students in grades 9 and 12 will assign work to be completed via Canvas while 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> graders are taking the test. Work assigned via Canvas will allow students to continue progressing in their classes. However, students testing will not be penalized. Students in SEL/Advisory are encouraged to bring earphones or earbuds on the day of testing, allowing them to watch videos uploaded by their teachers.
