Parents, this is your first homework assignment. You must read it carefully! There are specific instructions for many of the items. A few of the supplies will be needed on the first day of school and some of the items are very specific. If you cannot find something, let me know. While we appreciate your generosity, we do not have very much storage space for extra items, so please do not buy something else instead. Do not put your child's name on any of the supplies, **with the exception** of the journals, as they will be collected and shared among the classroom throughout the year.

- 2 sewn-bound (not spiral) journals that are at least about 5"x 8" --needed by the first day.
- 3 Quad Ruled Marble Notebooks (4 squares per inch only, which can be found at the office supply stores, such as Office Max
- 3 **Wide** ruled marble notebooks-**black and white only**
- 1 doz. Ticonderoga pencils
- small metal pencil sharpener
- 5 plain paper type (inexpensive) **three prong** solid color folders in red, yellow, blue or green
- 1 Method lavender spray cleaner
- Trash bags-tall kitchen drawstring only

The following items are also needed for the classroom. **Please choose at least three items** to buy.

- Modeling clay
- Paper plates
- 1 pack of **wide ruled** loose leaf paper
- Tissues
- Napkins
- Scissors
