

Hello Families!

My name is Ms. Brittany and I am pleased to be your child's Primary teacher here at Park Road Montessori. I cannot wait for the school year to begin! I love the Montessori philosophy and I cannot wait to pass on my passion for Montessori learning to your children! In order to help your child ease into the new school year, we will implement staggered entry. Information on this procedure and which days your child will attend is enclosed. Below is a list of items that your child will need to start off the school year. I will send requests for other supplies during the year as we learn about our class.

Other supplies and Procedures:

Your child will require a *standard sized* shoulder backpack that can fit library books, a folder and their nap towel. No wheeled backpacks please as we don't have room for them. They also need a change of clothes in a labeled gallon size ziplock bag. This change of clothes should include a shirt, pants, underwear, and a pair of socks. Your child will also require a pair of classroom crocs. These crocs should be solid in color, no fur or decorations, and will be kept and worn only in the classroom. These shoes will also serve as extra shoes in the event of an accident. If your child stays all day, they will also need a labeled bath sized towel. Towel, crocs, spare clothes, and supplies can be delivered the first day of school or at the open house.

Snack week:

Each child will be assigned a snack week throughout the school year. Snack lists will be sent out on the Friday before the week through email. A sign-up genius will be sent out in the first weeks of school to choose your snack weeks, otherwise weeks will be assigned.

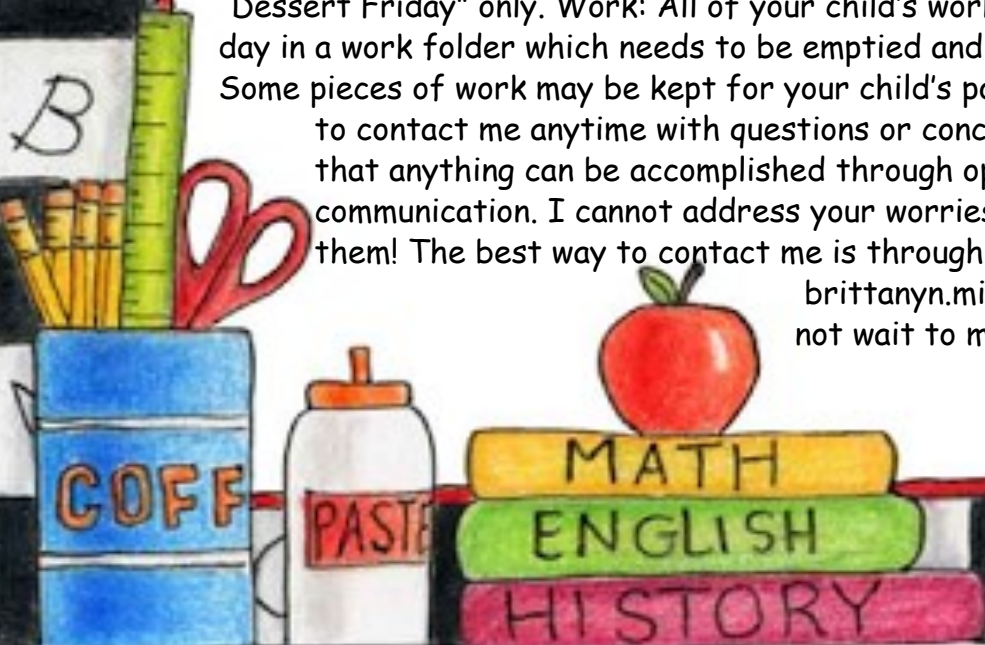
Lunch:

Required

- 1-large (must fit library book, towel, and folder) backpack (no wheels)
- 1-lunchbox (able to fit water bottle inside or in side pocket)
- 1- pair of crocs (plain color, no decoration please)
- 1- bag of nylon craft loops
- 3- Crayola water colors sets
- 2-wide-ruled composition books (black & white)
- 2-boxes of 12-count washable markers
- 1-package of EXPO dry erase markers (black)
- 1-box of gallon-size Ziploc bags (boys) sandwich-size (girls)
- 2 large pink erasers (not toppers)
- 5-containers of disinfectant wipes
- 3-boxes of Kleenex
- 1-bottle of hand sanitizer
- One large bag of pony beads
- Kindergarten- one box of sidewalk chalk and one pack of dry erase markers (any color)
- Pre-K- 3 pack of playdough, one pack of colored tissue paper
