

Dear Parents and Students,

Welcome to Ms. Sherry, and Ms. Danielle's Lower Elementary Class at Park Road Montessori. We hope you had a wonderful summer! We are looking forward to the upcoming school year and all that it has to offer. Our classroom is the last classroom on the right in the C wing modular, room C 2.

We are continuing to ask each child to bring in their own supplies and keep track of everything in their cubby. This will require students to replenish their own supplies when they run low.

\*\*\*Due to limited closet space, we prefer that your child bring a small bag to carry a book they are reading or to bring home papers. \*\*\*

The following is a shopping list of what each child will need:

- 1 - Two-Pocket Folder with Prong Fasteners for their Cultural Work Folder.
- 2 - **Wide-ruled Primary (K-2) Composition Notebooks**. These need to be sewn bound to last. These notebooks will be used for Language/Spelling and Writing/Reading. They may be any color. If possible, please try to locate the primary notebook that has writing lines the entire length of the page (NO blank space for drawing at the top).
- 2 - **Wide-ruled** Composition Notebooks. These also need to be sewn bound to last. This notebook will be used for Math and give the student an extra notebook. They may be any color.
- 1- Plastic Envelope With Button & String Closure, Letter-Size, 9 3/4" x 13". This will be used for transporting papers to and from school and will be referred to as the Home Folder.
- Pencil case with the following items placed inside:
  - 5 + - Pencils #2 - any color or style allowed - have your child sharpen these prior to school starting.
  - Extra erasers (caps or blocks)
  - 2 - Glue sticks
  - 2 - Handheld pencil sharpeners
  - 1 - Pair of scissors
  - 1 - Headphones for device use.
  - 2 - Packs of colored pencils
  - 1 - Small pack of crayons (8 or 16 pack)
  - One small pack of Crayola broad line markers.
- Coloring book (Dollar store is a great resource.) The children will be allowed to color during our daily read aloud time. Please avoid the activity books as they require the students focus on the task in the book rather than listening attentively to the read aloud story.

The following is a shopping list for the classroom:

- 1 - Roll of paper towels
- 1 - Box of tissues (***Due to allergies, please get aloe free tissues.***)
- 1 - Ream of pastel colored copier paper (**Need: purple, pink, or cream colored please**)

Each child should bring **ONE** of the following items:

1st Graders:

- 1 box of bandaids
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer (8 to 16 oz bottles please)
- 1 bottle of all purpose cleaner spray (**no clorox please**)

2nd Graders:

- 1 box of Ziploc bags - gallon size
- 1 pack of loose Leaf paper (wide ruled)
- 1 Pack of inexpensive washcloths

3rd Graders:

- 1 box of Ziploc bags - sandwich size
- 1 bottle of hand soap (7.5oz or 8oz)
- **Boys:** 1 bottle of liquid dish soap
- **Girls:** 1 container of disinfecting wipes
