**What if my student needs to go home a different way than we discussed?**

If there is a transportation change for your student, please call the front office (980-343-3620) and we will communicate the change with your student. You may also text your student and he/she will have time to check his/her phone prior to dismissal.

**What if my student gets sick at school?**

If your student starts to feel poorly at school, he/she may go to the nurses office and the school nurse will assess your student. If your student is sick, he/she may call you from the nurse phone or his/her own cell phone while in the office.

**Can my student access his phone during lunch?**

No. Your student may not access their phone during lunch or between classes. Phones MUST stay in backpacks all day.

**Can my student wear her fitbit or apple watch to school?**

Yes. Devices worn on the wrist are allowed as long as they do not make any noise and are not used for communication while at school.

**Can my student wear and use headphones/earbuds during school?**

Yes, only during teacher condoned instructional activities, otherwise they may not be worn.

**What if my student's sports practice or game is canceled, how will I be notified?**

If a sports practice or game is canceled, athletes will be allowed to contact a family member under teacher supervision.

**Can my student bring his/her phone on a field trip?**

This Student Personal Technology Use practice will apply to school activities on and off campus. It is subject to change and explicitly communicated by school personnel.

**What happens to my student's phone if it is taken away?**

If your student does not follow the QHMS Personal Technology Use Practice, his/her phone will be taken and turned into the front office (or other designated location).

**How long will my student have to turn his/her phone into the office?**

- 1st offense- Rest of school day
- 2nd offense- Rest of school day and 4 additional school days
- 3rd offense- Rest of school day and 9 additional school days
