Saturday Enrichment/EOG Program

Beginning March 13, 2021 Wilson STEM Academy will be offering a Saturday School/EOG Enrichment program for 6th, 7th, and 8th grade scholars, *for in-person learning only*. The program will be opened to all scholars who attend Wilson STEM academy. The program will be primarily designed to increase proficiency with math, ELA, and Science. We are also adding a component of Physical Education to get our scholars moving and to assist with their physical health. The Saturday enrichment class hours of operation will be from 8:30 am-12:30 pm. Each student will attend 2 courses for 120 minutes and then they will switch to a different class for an additional 120 minutes which will make up the second half of the enrichment/EOG program each day. Unfortunately, we will have to cap the program at 75 scholars to continue to ensure the safety of the students and staff that attend the program as we are still in a COVID-19 environment.

Transportation will not be provided for this program. Parents will be expected to bring scholars to Wilson STEM Academy on Saturday mornings between 8:15-8:30. The expectation is that all scholars will be picked up from the Saturday Enrichment program by 12:45 pm. Scholars who are not picked up by 12:45 pm may be removed from the Saturday program. All scholars who attend the program will be provided a snack each Saturday that they attend.

The program will be based on teaching the essential standards in science, ELA, and math. Our scholars will be engaged in authentic and active learning throughout the day. Technology, cooperative learning, and student engagement will be used to increase academic achievement for our scholars. We expect that all students will arrive with a fully charged device, paper and writing utensils. Appropriate behavior will be the expectations of all scholars. Cell phones and other electronic devices not supplied by Wilson STEM academy will not be allowed for use until students leave the classroom to go home. Register as soon as possible to reserve your scholar a seat in the Program.
